Your Task:

Work in teams to create a trustworthy, impactful, interesting and useful visualisation which uses data to tell a story of relevance to our times.

How you will do this:

- 1. Using the skills that you have developed, explore, interrogate and analyse one of the datasets provided (and/or your own sourced data) to identify the story you wish to tell on one of the themes that have been identified as relevant to our times and to young people:
 - Equity, diversity, and inclusion
 - The climate crisis
 - The cost of living
 - Mental health and well-being
- 2. Present your data visually and creatively using what you have learned about data art and visualisation. Try to be as creative as possible while still clearly illustrating the stories of the data.
 - You might want to consider whether you are going to create a piece of data art or data visualisation and whether you are going to present the data in a way in which it can be read or take a more conceptual approach.
- 3. Record your processes in a way that illustrates what you have learned. This will need to be presented as part of your final piece, so consider how best to do this in an engaging and informative way.

You should illustrate how you have used:

- The core data skills
- The power skills
- Data visualisation approaches
- Employability skills, specifically: creativity & innovation, teamwork, communication, problem solving, decision-making & initiative.

You should also make clear:

- How and why you made the decisions you did.
- Why you didn't make certain decisions or how you changed along the way.
- What you are illustrating.
- How it uses the data.
- How it reveals a story that is relevant to our time.
